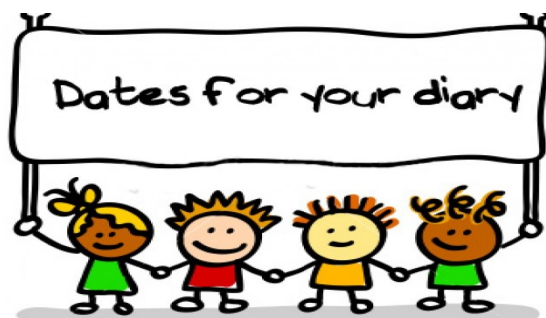

We have children in school with severe nut allergies.

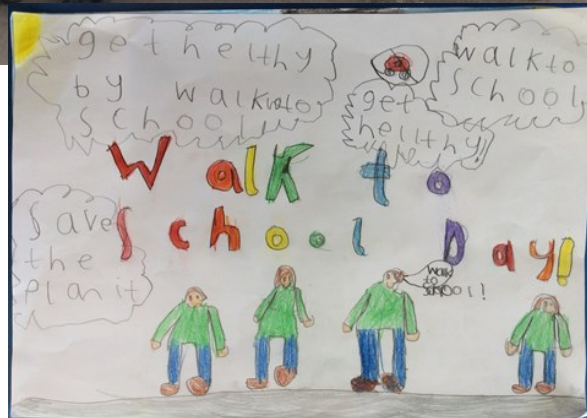
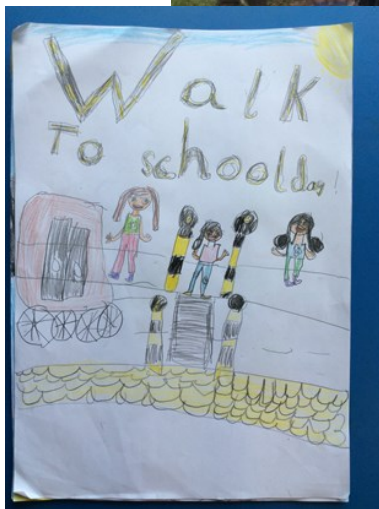
Starting Little Oaks in September 2023
